



YOM KIPPURIM—DAY OF ATONEMENT 2007 SEPTEMBER 21ST-22ND @ 7:00 PM

Yom Kippur is the Jewish holiday of the Day of Atonement. It falls on the tenth day of the Hebrew month of Tishri. The Bible calls the day Yom Hakippurim (Hebrew, "Day of the Atonements"). The day is commemorated with a 25-hour fast and intensive prayer. It is considered the holiest day of the Jewish year.

It is the Day of Atonement -- *"For on this day He will forgive you, to purify you, that you be cleansed from all your sins before G-d"* (Leviticus 16:30).

The major theme of Yom Kippur, as its name implies, is atonement. The source for much of our observance of Yom Kippur is Leviticus 23:26-28 - *"God spoke to Moses, saying: Mark, the tenth day of this seventh month is the Day of Atonement. It shall be a sacred occasion for you: you shall practice self-denial, and you shall do no work throughout that day for it is a Day of Atonement, on which expiation is made on your behalf before the Lord your God."*

The day is devoted to communal repentance for sins committed over the course of the previous year. Join us for a time of prayer, repentance, forgiveness, healing, deliverance, restoration and atonement.
